

Senior Integration Engineer – Scottsdale, AZ

OVERVIEW

The Senior Integration Engineer is responsible for the design, implementation, testing, and maintenance of middleware technology platform. The Engineer has a complete understanding and application of principles, concepts, practices and standards. In this role, they will be responsible for evaluating complex business requirements and determining the best processes and tools to be used, and assisting in and directing the design and development of the organization's middleware technology architecture plan, as well as communicating it to the rest of IT and the business. They must have a complete understanding of the business processes as well as technical requirements for successful software implementations. They will also need to possess a strong understanding of the infrastructure components required to support it. This role ensures the overall quality of the system.

Work is performed under general direction. This role will participate in determining the team's objectives and will plan schedules and arrange activities in order to accomplish objectives.

The ideal candidate will represent the IT organization as the prime customer contact and may function in a leadership role. They will interact with senior level internal and external customers, technical developers and analysts, and third-party data partners on significant matters often requiring the coordination of activity across organizational lines. It is also required that this candidate participates on or lead work teams. They may provide work direction or guidance to a group of employees as well as mentor less experienced employees.
